Liberty Township Regular Board Meeting

Supervisor Monroe opened the meeting at 7:33pm

Present: Monroe, Deibert, Heady, Talbot and Bogart

Absent: None

Visitors: Bob Fountain and Karen Talbot

Minutes: Move to approve the minutes as presented by Supervisor Monroe, 2nd by Trustee Heady. All in favor.

Correspondence:

- Michigan Railroad article on RR being private property and the hazards of trespassing
- Wexford County-911 Plan Amendment/Wexford County has adopted a 9-1-1 Service Plan Amendment to update & modernize the County's existing plan.
- Kurt Shindler-Article about state of Michigan passing legislation taking away rights & responsibilities from townships.
- Thank You from the Stockwell family for use of the Township Hall after funeral for Pikes.

Financial Report: Treasurer gave the financial report and bills were presented for approval.

Beckman had brined the roads and due to the heavier application the cost was more than budgeted for.

Supervisor made a motion to increase the Streets and Highways budget by \$2000.00 and reducing the General Fund by \$2000.00, 2nd by Treasurer Deibert. Roll Call Vote: Bogart "yes", Heady "yes", Talbot "yes", Monroe "yes" and Deibert "yes".

Treasurer noted that Forest Area Federal Credit Union deducted monies from the savings account rather than the debit account set up for Lee Deibert. She will have them correct.

Clerk made a motion to accept the treasurer's report and pay outstanding bills, 2nd by Heady. Roll Call Vote: Monroe "yes", Deibert "yes", Bogart "yes", Talbot "yes" and Heady "yes".

Unfinished Business: Cemetery Pump cover is still in the works. Lee is working on the electrical to light the cemetery flag.

New Business: Issues with hall restroom will need to have a plumber look at.

Treasurer Deibert mentioned the flags for Veterans graves are of poor quality, coming apart, she will contact the company about this.

Supervisor noted the Board of Review will meet on July 18th at 4:30pm.
